## Luxurious & Tropical White

- 18. St Aubin 1er Cru, Domaine Gilles Bouton, 2010 (Fr)**<sup>12% ABV</sup> **£35.50**  
Deliciously rich with plenty of body and nicely balanced oak.
- 19. Gavi “La Battistina” 2010 (Italy)**<sup>12.5% ABV</sup> **£24.50**  
Enticing aromas of peach and crystallised ginger followed by deliciously fresh and zesty citrus flavours.
- 20. Chardonnay Reserve, Castle Creek 2010 (Aus)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£19.50**  
Deliciously ripe with no trace of oak, elegant and quite restrained for its type. Good quaffer and easy to drink.
- 21. Dry Muscat, Domaine Astruc 2010 (France)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£20.50**  
Quite the most moreish of all white grapes, juicy and generous yet with a zippy clean finish. Definitely worth trying!
- 22. St. Veran, Domaine de Maillettes 2009 (Burgundy)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£35.50**  
Big and bold! This is a powerful wine with plenty of fruit balanced with plenty of structure and length.
- 23. Falanghina, Cantine dei Cipressi 2010 (Italy)**<sup>12.5% ABV</sup> **£19.50**  
Luscious and ripe with plenty of sunshine and a complex, voluptuous finish. Full ripeness of fruit balanced with freshness.
- 24. Sauvignon/Semillon, Xanadu 2010 (Australia)**<sup>12.5% ABV</sup> **£22.95**  
Fresh and vibrant aromas with lychee and lemon. Spicy tropical fruits mingled with citrus flavours.
- 25. Viognier, Mandrarossa 2010 (Sicily)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£19.50**  
Bright gold in colour with fresh and spicy aromas and lashings of tropical fruit all ending with a refreshing finish.

## Supple & Silky Red

- 26. Primitivo Salento, Puglia 2010 (Italy)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£17.95**  
Plums and strawberry jam fruit cleverly balanced with plenty of power and weight but remaining medium bodied.
- 27. Rioja Semi Crianza, Azabache 2009 (Spain)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£21.50**  
Plenty of savoury, gamey notes on the palate. Succulent and soft with elegant fruit.
- 28. Pagos de Ariz Crianza, Navarra 2007 (Spain)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£19.50**  
Lashings of ripe forest fruits with a well integrated toasty character. Complex and long with medium body and structure.
- 29. Carignan Vielle Vignes, Les Archères '10 (France)**<sup>12.5% ABV</sup> **£18.95**  
Ruby red cherry fruit with hints of vanilla and plenty of complexity. Full flavoured and easy drinking - classic Languedoc.
- 30. Pinot Noir, Yering Station, Victoria 2008 (Australia)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£25.50**  
An amazing silky elegance to the fruit with dark bramble and damson notes, spicy, savoury finish.
- 31. VINO Nobile de Montepulciano 1489 2007 (Italy)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£23.50**  
Fresh and attractive with soft red berry fruit and hints of spice balanced with an elegantly smooth caressing finish.
- 32. Beaujolais Villages, Victor Berard 2010 (France)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£19.95**  
Light and elegant fruit with soft, juicy flavours, cleverly balanced with a lick of acidity to give a good all round, well structured wine.
- 33. Nero d'Avola, Doricum 2010 (Sicily)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£19.95**  
Warm, rich and deliciously velvety with ripe and meaty currant fruit balanced with a complex spicy character.

## Supple & Silky Red

- 34. Shiraz/Grenache, Peter Lehmann 2010 (Aus)**<sup>14% ABV</sup> **£20.50**  
Dark red fruits and a touch of background aniseed. Richly flavoured fruit driven wine with a beautifully soft finish.
- 35. Cotes du Ventoux Les Boudalles 2010 (France)**<sup>13% ABV</sup> **£24.50**  
Raspberries fruit dominates with supple, harmonious and elegant aromatics.
- 36. Côtes du Rhone Villages “Les Coteaux” 2008 (Fr)**<sup>14% ABV</sup> **£24.50**  
This has a delightful, smoky, spiced quality allied to autumnal fruit and darker savoury notes.
- 37. Bonizio Toscano Rosso Cecchi, 2009 (Italy)**<sup>13.0% ABV</sup> **£19.95**  
Made from Sangiovese in Maremma, this wine is full and complex with ripe red fruit and Mediterranean herbs.

## Warm & Hearty Reds

- 38. Cabernet Sauvignon, Trapiche 2009 (Argentina)**<sup>14.5% ABV</sup> **£19.95**  
Chunky and gutsy this has plenty of weight and power balanced with beautifully ripe juicy fruit.
- 39. Crozes Hermitage, Chapoutier 2008 (France)**<sup>12.5% ABV</sup> **£28.95**  
Masses of power, but softened by sexy, silky jammy, juicy fruit! Big enough to stand up to any red meat.
- 40. Séguret, “Les Coteaux Shisteaux” 2007 (France)**<sup>14.5% ABV</sup> **£29.50**  
Incredible intensity from Syrah and Grenache grapes grown on the craggy slopes of this historic village in the Southern Rhône. Rich black cherries and vanilla with hints of spice.
- 41. Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto 2009 (Portugal)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£24.50**  
Vibrant and fresh with intense blackberry and raspberry fruit. Rich and full bodied with great structure and length
- 42. Carmenere Reserva, Montevista 2010 (Chile)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£19.95**  
Lush, velvety and seductive! Black cherries, dark chocolate and liquorice all combined to give a big and satisfying mouthful!
- 43. Biferno Rosso Riserva, Molise 2007 (Italy)**<sup>13.0% ABV</sup> **£20.50**  
Purple red colour with intense blackberry jam flavours. Velvety and harmonious with pleasant firm tannins.
- 44. Malbec Blend, Amalaya, Colomé '10 (Argentina)**<sup>14.5% ABV</sup> **£20.95**  
Deep and dark yet elegant and refined fruit. Ripe cherry and chocolate balanced with smooth tannins.
- 45. Pinotage, Lutzville 2010 (South Africa)**<sup>14% ABV</sup> **£19.50**  
This is a wonderful example of the spicy speciality from South Africa. Soft juicy fruit with plenty of oomph!
- 46. Stickleback Red, Heartland 2009 (Australia)**<sup>14% ABV</sup> **£24.95**  
Spicy, jammy blend of Shiraz, Cabernet and a splash of Dolcetto. Rich and savoury with great length.
- 47. Cabernet Sauvignon, La Forge Estate 2010 (Fr)**<sup>14% ABV</sup> **£24.50**  
Wild ripeness of sweet scented fruit twinned with rich edgy yet fleshy fruit and an incredibly long finish.
- 48. Château Montouliers, Minervois '10 (France)**<sup>13.5% ABV</sup> **£18.50**  
Intense and vibrant with spicy aromas of redcurrant and bramble. Deliciously fresh with soft, ripe tannins.
